Health & Safety Policy

ECL is firmly committed to a Health & Safety policy that enables all work activities to be carried out safely, and with all possible measures taken to reduce or remove risks to the health, safety and welfare of employees, contractors, authorised visitors, and anyone else who may be affected by our operations.

ECL management will provide and maintain as far as possible:

- a safe working environment
- safe systems of work
- plant and substances in safe condition
- facilities for the welfare of workers
- information, instruction, training and supervision that is reasonably necessary to ensure that each worker is safe from injury and risks to health
- a commitment to consult and co-operate with workers in all matters relating to health and safety in the workplace
- a commitment to continually improve our performance through effective safety management.

ECL employees have an obligation to:

- comply with safe work practices, with the intent of avoiding injury to themselves and others and damage to plant and equipment
- take reasonable care of the health and safety of themselves and others
- wear Personal Protective Equipment and clothing where necessary
- comply with any direction given by management for health and safety
- not misuse or interfere with anything provided for health and safety
- report all accidents and incidents immediately, including near-misses
- report all known or observed hazards to their line manager.

Application of this policy:

ECL management will continually seek the cooperation of employees, customers and other parties relating to our business operations. We encourage suggestions for realising our health and safety objectives to create a safe working environment with a zero-accident rate.

This policy applies to all business operations and functions, particularly those situations where employees are required to work at customers' sites.
